Who is eligible?

Individuals with income up to \$35,000;

Families with income up to \$55,000

Please bring the following documents with you:

- Social Security card or ITIN letter for each family member
- Valid Photo ID for taxpayer (and spouse if filing jointly) and all W-2s and 1099s
- Dependents' income documents
- If you purchased health insurance through the marketplace, bring Form 1095-A
- Income documents for each job held in 2018 (W2, 1099, list of cash payments)
- 2017 tax return, if available
- Record of expenses for tax credits and deductions (child care, education, savings, student loans, medical)
- Bring the account and routing numbers of the account where you would like your refunds deposited
